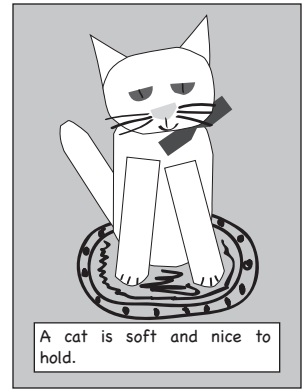


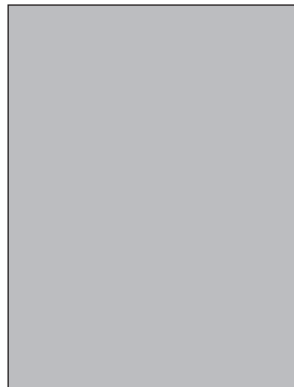

You Will Need For Each Child

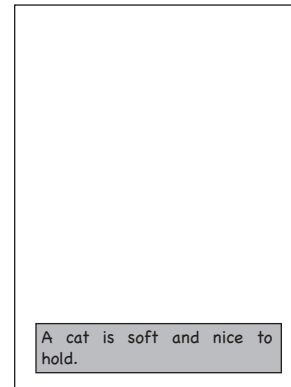

| Background | 1 pink rectangle | 9" | x | 12" |
| Text | | | | |
| Body | 1 white rectangle | 3" | x | 5" |
| Head | 1 white rectangle | 2½" | x | 3½" |
| Legs | 1 white rectangle | 1" | x | 8" |
| Ears | 1 white square | 1½" | x | 1½" |
| Tail | 1 white rectangle | 1" | x | 4" |
| Eyes | 1 green square | ¾" | x | ¾" |
| Nose | 1 pink rectangle | ½" | x | ¾" |
| Bow | 1 royal blue rectangle | ½" | x | 2½" |
| Scissors, glue, black and blue crayons, pencil | | | | |

1.) Background: (pink rectangle)



- Place the pink rectangle in a vertical position on the table

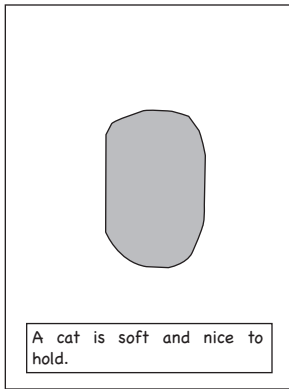
2.) Text:



- Glue the text near the bottom of the pink rectangle

3.) Body:

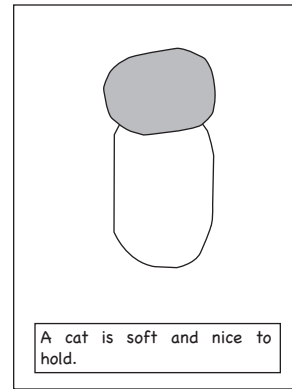
(largest white rectangle)



- Cut an oval;
(See TLC Cuts for "oval cut" instructions)
- Glue the body in a vertical position to the pink rectangle as shown

4.) Head:

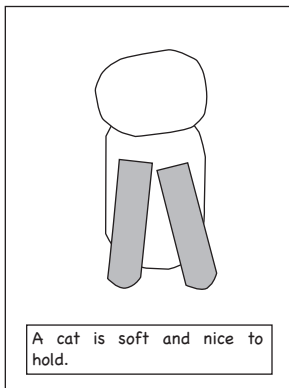
(next largest white rectangle)



- Cut an oval
- Glue the head in a horizontal position to the body as shown

5.) Legs:

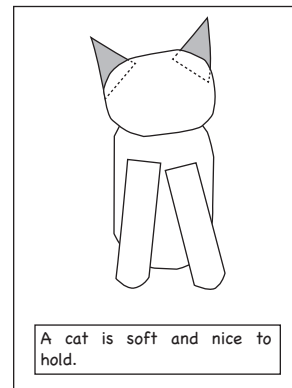
(longest narrow white rectangle)



- Fold the rectangle in half so you can cut two legs at a time
- Hold the folded rectangle in a vertical position; cut off the top two corners and round; open and cut apart on the fold line
(See TLC Cuts for "hill cut" instructions)
- Glue the legs to the body as shown

6.) Ears:

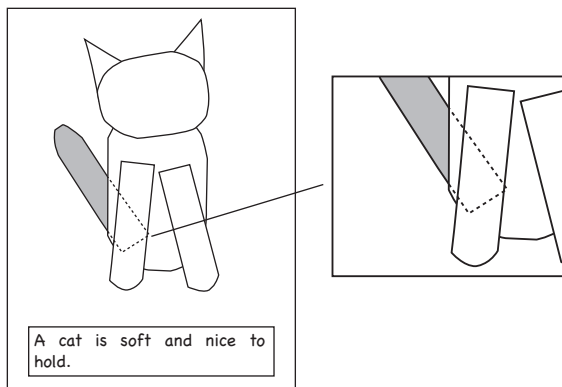
(white square)



- Cut the square on a diagonal line from corner to corner to make two triangles
(See TLC Cuts for "triangle cut" instructions)
- Lift the head and glue the ears as shown

7.) Tail:

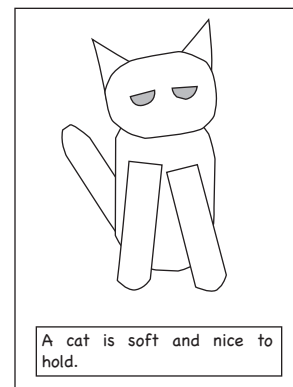
(next longest narrow white rectangle)



- Hold the rectangle in a vertical position; cut off the two top corners and round
- Lift the body and glue the tail as shown

8.) Eyes:

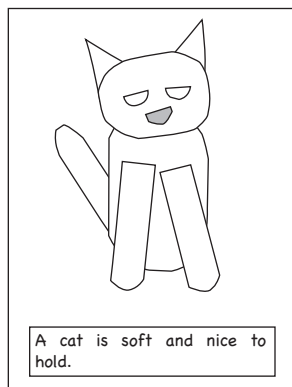
(green square)



- Cut a circle;
(See TLC Cuts for "circle cut" instructions)
- Cut the circle in half
- Glue the eyes on the head as shown

9.) Nose:

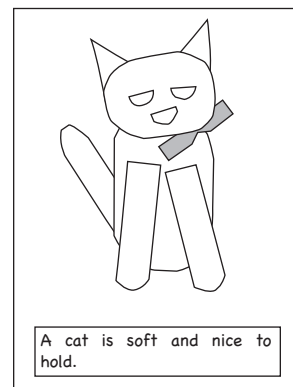
(pink rectangle)



- Hold the rectangle in a horizontal position; cut off the top two corners and round
- Glue the nose on the head as shown

10.) Bow:

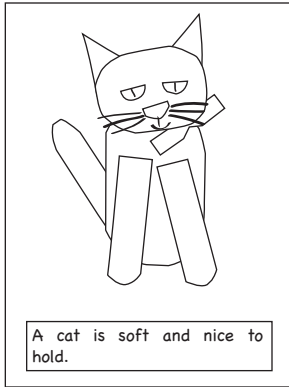
(royal blue rectangle)



- Fold the rectangle in half
- Hold the folded rectangle in a vertical position with the fold at the top; cut off the top two corners
- Lift the head and glue the bow as shown

11.) Details:

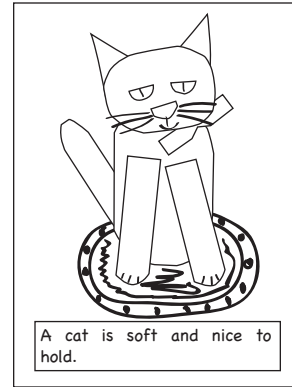
(black crayon)



- Use the black crayon to draw the cat's features

12.) Rug (optional):

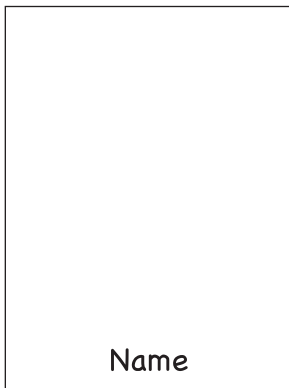
(blue crayon)



- Use the blue crayon to draw a rug; make it look like the cat is sitting on a rug as shown

13.) Name:

(pencil)



- Turn your paper over; write your name at the bottom of the paper
